When incomes fall short of basic needs, families are forced to make unthinkable tough choices, such as deciding between essential medications, quality child care, and paying the rent. ALICE’s unmet needs can become costly emergencies. The future success of our communities is directly tied to the financial stability of these fragile households. We support community programs that help more residents meet their needs and build assets.



HEALTH: WE STRENGTHENING FAMILY CAREGIVERS

The financial and personal demands of caregiving can place even more stress on already strained budgets, frayed emotions, and compromised physical well-being. For some, especially ALICE, choices are limited – they cannot afford not to work nor can they afford outside help with their caregiving. We support community programs that offer unpaid family caregivers resources to navigate their physical, emotional, and financial challenges.

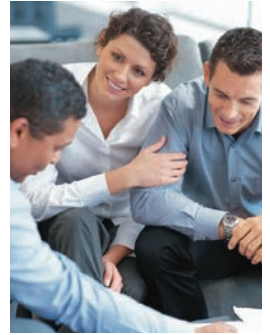
